Thank you to the



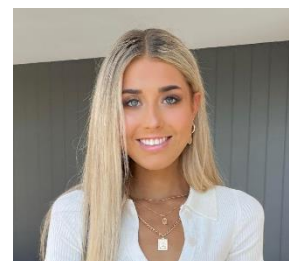
