In class and at school we need to have a refillable drink bottle.

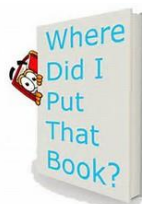
Bring it to school filled with **water only** for a good reason it keeps us hydrated and healthy.
